



## Kindergarten Supplies

Please provide your child with the following items for school:

- 1 backpack-NO WHEELS (large enough to fit a folder and books)
- 4 folders (bottom pockets)
- 1 composition notebook (no spirals)
- 1 supply box (8x5 hard plastic)
- 10 sharpened Ticonderoga BEGINNERS or Laddie pencils with erasers
- 1 soft eraser
- 2 boxes Crayola JUMBO crayons (8 pack)
- 2 boxes Crayola regular size crayons (16 pack)
- 1 pair child Fiskars scissors
- 4 LARGE Elmer's glue sticks
- 2 fine point Expo dry erase markers & 1 eraser (or 1 old clean sock)
- 1 highlighter (any color)
- 1 pack post-it notes (any color)
- 1 complete change of uniform clothes in a ziploc bag labeled with your child's name (pants, shirt, underwear, socks)
- 1 small pillow for rest time (mini pillow pets are fine)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 container Lysol or Clorox wipes

Do not send any other items to school (note pads, markers, toys, rulers...) Check your child's backpack daily and clean out unnecessary items. Also, please LABEL EVERYTHING with your child's name and grade.

- 1 JUMBO BOOK SOX**
- 2 PACKS BLACK DRY ERASE MARKERS (4)**
- 2 PACKS MULTICOLOR DRY ERASE MARKERS (4)**
- 1 BOX OF TISSUES**
- 1 CONTAINER OF BABY WIPES**
